 - Review w/ ED at the end of each term.
- Attends all business meetings, lunches and plans with BOD for there to be one BOD member at major events.
- Makes room in his schedule for emails and phone calls that pertain to Forerunner.
- Spend time praying for Forerunner as the Lord leads

GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE

- Finds, interviews, nominates and trains new BOD members
- Connect with ED to plan business meetings and board retreats
- Oversees vision of FMP
- Lead BOD in a self-evaluation
- Leads BOD connects and BOD meetings
- Keeps minutes at board connects and meetings
- Recruits and on-boards new board members

FINANCE COMMITTEE


- Oversee 1-3 year budget

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The Executive Committee supports the Executive Director and makes sure he has everything he needs to run Forerunner well.


BOARD OF DIRECTORS EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
