- We offer grace to others when they fail, not judgement.

#### What this looks like:

- We are not here to fix the people that we serve. We focus on the relationship, not the results or their progress.
- We stay near the Lord and focus on the positive to avoid becoming discouraged.
- We understand that the enemy wants to destroy us, our people, and our ministry. We also understand that he wants us to walk in negativity and to believe the lies he tells us about our people and our work.
- We work hard and do what he calls us to do. Everything else we let go and let God control.
- We give ourselves grace when things do not go as planned.
